

ECE 126/128 – Homework Policy

- Homework is to be done individually, no exceptions.
- Homework is due electronically (by email or blackboard) 1 hour prior to lab on the due date.
- A hard copy must be submitted at the start of the lab.
(hard copy meaning: printed paper copy; color preferred, black and white is acceptable if graphic images are legible. You may annotate the hard copy with pen or pencil if you wish to make something more legible)
- If the grader cannot read either the electronic or printed copy, if numbers or graphs are not legible, problem will be given a 0.
- Assignment will be considered 1 day late if student is found working on the HW after the start of the lab.
- If you will not be in lab the day the assignment is due, you must send the assignment electronically to both the instructor and the grader on the due date.
- Homework submitted after the due date will have 10 points deducted per day after due date.
- Cheating will not be tolerated. If a student has been found cheating both students involved will be given a 0 for the assignment. More than one occurrence will be referred to GWU academic council.
